PURPOSE:

Establish criteria for documentation of patients leaving AMA (Against Medical Advice).

POLICY:

- All patients indicating the desire to leave against medical advice shall sign the AMA form.
 - The Registered Nurse and/or physician shall discuss with the patient and/or family, the potential risks of leaving AMA and the benefits of remaining.
 - The AMA form shall state the possible risks of leaving AMA and the benefits of remaining.
 - If after explanation of possible risks, the patient still wishes to leave AMA, request that the patient sign the AMA form and give a copy to the patient.
 - The Registered Nurse shall instruct the patient to follow up with his/her family physician or return if his/her condition worsens.
 - Document the patient's desire to leave AMA, conversations on potential complications and patient's condition prior to leaving the Emergency Department.
- In the event the patient leaves prior to an evaluation by the physician and does not notify any staff member of leaving, the Registered Nurse shall document the elopement of the patient in the nursing notes. An incident report shall be initiated for follow-up.
