## All Creenshaw Community Hosptal patients that are requested to give a urine sample must be given education on proper cleaning prior to sampling!

**Important Note**: All specimen containers must be labeled with both the patient's first and last names as well as a second identifier such as the patient's medical record number or date of birth.

A clean-catch urine specimen is a sample of urine. It is necessary in order to test your urine for bacteria, which may be causing an infection in your urinary tract. A clean-catch specimen is a way of collecting urine that does not contain a lot of bacteria from the skin. Please follow these instructions to collect a clean-catch midstream urine specimen:

With a new towelette, clean the center area stream and collect a "midstream" and discard towelette. specimen. Stop when the container is 8. With a third new towelette, clean the other approximately half full. side and discard towelette. 8. Finish urinating in the toilet. 9. Continue to hold the folds open and begin 9.
